

Timetable for Postage-free Election Mail 2022 Chief Executive Election

Key dates	Procedures
<p>3 April – 27 April 2022 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>A Candidate can submit his/her specimens of postage-free election mail at either one of the following Hongkong Post offices:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● General Post Office, Central ● G/F, Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) According to the latest legislative amendments, letters that may be posted free of postage <u>must not be larger than 165 mm x 245 mm</u> instead of 175 mm x 245 mm in size and <u>must not exceed 5 mm in thickness</u>;</p> <p>(2) To save time, a Candidate may consider submitting his/her specimen(s) of postage-free election mail before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mail; and</p> <p>(3) Once the specimen(s) concerned has/have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, a Candidate may insert the candidate number or printing details into that election mail <u>without altering the approved design and content of the election mail</u>.</p>
<p>3 April – 3 May 2022 (except Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>A Candidate can post postage-free election mail at either one of the following acceptance offices of Hongkong Post:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● General Post Office, Central ● Bulk Mail Acceptance Counter of Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) A Candidate must select one of the acceptance offices to post his/her postage-free election mail when handing in the specimen(s) and “Notice of Posting of Election Mail” to Hongkong Post; and</p> <p>(2) A Candidate must furnish the Postmaster General with a security (i.e. full postage of all the election mail posted) if postings of his/her postage-free election mail are made before the publication of the notice of valid nomination(s) in the Gazette.</p>
