3 April – 27 April 2022 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)	<ul> <li>A Candidate can submit his/her specimens of postage-free election mail at either one of the following Hongkong Post offices:-</li> <li>General Post Office, Central</li> <li>G/F, Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay</li> <li>Remarks:</li> <li>(1) According to the latest legislative amendments, letters that may be posted free of postage must not be larger than 165 mm x 245 mm instead of 175 mm x 245 mm in size and must not exceed 5 mm in thickness;</li> <li>(2) To save time, a Candidate may consider submitting his/her specimen(s) of postage-free election mail before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mail; and</li> <li>(3) Once the specimen(s) concerned has/have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, a Candidate may insert the candidate number or printing</li> </ul>
	details into that election mail without altering the approved design and content of the election mail.
3 April – 3 May 2022 (except Sunday and public holiday)	<ul> <li>A Candidate can post postage-free election mail at either one of the following acceptance offices of Hongkong Post:-</li> <li>General Post Office, Central</li> <li>Bulk Mail Acceptance Counter of Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay</li> <li>Remarks:</li> <li>(1) A Candidate must select one of the acceptance offices to post his/her postage-free election mail when handing in the specimen(s) and "Notice"</li> </ul>
	of Posting of Election Mail" to Hongkong Post; and  (2) A Candidate must furnish the Postmaster General with a security (i.e. full postage of all the election mail posted) if postings of his/her postage-free election mail are made before the publication of the notice of valid nomination(s) in the Gazette.
