

Timetable for Postage-free Election Mail **2023 District Council Ordinary Election**

Key dates	Procedures
<p>17 October – 22 November 2023 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>Candidates can submit their specimens of postage-free election mail at any one of the following Hongkong Post offices:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● General Post Office, Central ● G/F, Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay ● 10/F, Tsuen Wan Government Offices, Tsuen Wan ● 1/F, Sha Tin Government Offices, Sha Tin <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) Under the prevailing legislation, letters that may be posted free of postage <u>must not be larger than 165 mm x 245 mm</u> in size and <u>must not exceed 5 mm in thickness at any part of the letter;</u></p> <p>(2) To save time, candidates may consider submitting their specimen(s) of postage-free election mail before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mail; and</p> <p>(3) Once the specimen(s) concerned has/have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, candidates may insert the candidate number or printing details into that election mail <u>without altering the approved design and content of the election mail.</u></p>
<p>17 October – 25 November 2023 (except Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>Candidates can post postage-free election mail at any one of the 17 designated acceptance offices.</p> <p>(For details, please refer to the Appendix II of “Summary on Free Postage for Election Mail”.)</p> <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) Candidates must select one of the acceptance offices to post their postage-free election mail when handing in the specimen(s) and “Notice of Posting of Election Mail” to Hongkong Post; and</p> <p>(2) Candidates must furnish the Postmaster General with a security (i.e. full postage of all the election mail posted) if postings of their postage-free election mail are made before the publication of the notice of valid nominations in the Gazette.</p>
