(Sections 10 and 13 of the Regulation)

## INSPECTION OF THE 2025 PROVISIONAL REGISTER OF ELECTORS AND THE OMISSIONS LIST FOR GEOGRAPHICAL CONSTITUENCIES

Pursuant to sections 10 and 13 of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration of Electors) (Legislative Council Geographical Constituencies) (District Council Geographical Constituencies) Regulation (Cap. 541A) (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulation"), it is hereby notified that—

- (a) a copy of the provisional register of electors for geographical constituencies or a copy of the specific section of such provisional register; and
- (b) a copy of the omissions list for geographical constituencies containing the names and principal residential addresses of persons who are no longer eligible to have their names included or who do not wish to remain registered in the geographical constituencies register,

are now available for inspection by specified persons<sup>1</sup> for a purpose related to the election from 1 August to 25 August 2025 (both days inclusive) during ordinary business hours (from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) from Mondays to Fridays (other than a general holiday). In accordance with sections 10(3A) and 13(4B) of the Regulation, only the first Chinese character (if the person's name is recorded in Chinese) or the first word (if the person's name is recorded in English) of an individual elector's name, his/her registered residential address and constituency are shown on the above provisional register of electors and omissions list to be provided for inspection by specified persons<sup>1</sup>.

The places for inspection are as follows-

- (a) Registration and Electoral Office: 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Treasury Building, 3 Tonkin Street West, Cheung Sha Wan, Kowloon; and
- (b) Registration and Electoral Office: 29<sup>th</sup> Floor, Standard Chartered Tower, Millennium City 1, 388 Kwun Tong Road, Kwun Tong, Kowloon.

Any person who considers that a registered person is not eligible to be registered as an elector or be registered in the section or subsection in which that person's name and principal residential address are recorded may, under section 14 of the Regulation, deliver in person<sup>2</sup> at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer not later than 25 August 2025 a notice of objection in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form

Any person who has made an application for registration but whose name is not recorded in the provisional register or whose name is included in the omissions list, or who has a claim regarding his or her particulars in the provisional register may, under section 15 of the Regulation, deliver in person<sup>3</sup> at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer not later than 25 August 2025 a notice of claim in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form.

If a claimant, an objector or a person being objected to wishes to review the ruling made by the Revising Officer, he/she must submit the review application form at the office of the Registry for Appeals to Revising Officer on or before 6:00 p.m., 11 September 2025 (Thursday). Details for submission of the application are set out in the application form.
