Note1 According to section 77(7)(a)(ii) of the EAC(EP)(LC) Reg, any ballot paper, which appears to be not marked in accordance with section 57(2) using the chop to be affixed to give a single “✓” in the circle opposite the names of the candidates of the elector’s or authorised representative’s choice, is questionable and the RO should decide whether the vote is to be counted. When making decision, if the RO believes the ballot paper is not marked with the chop provided at the polling station, the vote is not to be counted pursuant to section 80(1)(hb).

Note2 For each of the four special FCs including the Agriculture and Fisheries and Transport FCs, an elector must mark the ballot paper to indicate his/her preference, by writing Arabic numbers in the circle opposite the names of the candidates in descending order of preference.

Note3 No first preference marked.

Note4 Marked with a first preference for two or more candidates.

Note5 Not applicable to the four special FCs.
