2018 Legislative Council Kowloon West Geographical Constituency By-election Submission of Nomination Form Points to Note

- 1. The 2018 Legislative Council Kowloon West Geographical Constituency By-election will be held on 25 November 2018, and the nomination period will run from 2 October 2018 to 15 October 2018 (both days inclusive).
- 2. Before completing and submitting the Nomination Form, candidate should read carefully the accompanying notes in the Nomination Form. Candidates must comply with the Guidelines on Election-related Activities in respect of the Legislative Council Election issued by the Electoral Affairs Commission ("EAC") in June 2016 and note the latest legislative changes and electoral arrangements after publication of the Guidelines. The relevant Guidelines and supplementary information can be found at the website of the EAC (www.eac.gov.hk). They are also available at the Registration and Electoral Office and the Home Affairs Enquiry Centres at Yau Tsim Mong, Sham Shui Po and Kowloon City District Offices.
- 3. The Nomination Form must be submitted by the nominated candidate in person to the Returning Officer within the nomination period. Due to limited space in the Returning Officer's office, the Returning Officer may, depending on circumstances, restrict the number of people accompanying a candidate during submission of nomination form.
- 4. According to the Legislative Council (Subscribers and Election Deposit for Nomination) Regulation (Cap. 542C), a nomination form of a geographical constituency must be personally subscribed and signed by not less than 100 subscribers, who must be registered electors for the relevant geographical constituency. A candidate should not sign as a subscriber in his/her nomination form. To avoid the risk of invalidation of the nomination if any subscriber is unqualified, the nomination form may be subscribed by more than 100 but not exceeding 200 subscribers.
