

**Delineation of Geographical Constituencies
for the 2020 Legislative Council General Election**

Working Principles

- (a) The existing boundaries of the 5 GCs should form the basis of consideration in the current delineation exercise;
- (b) For those existing GCs where the population falls within the permissible range of the population quota requirement, their boundaries will as far as possible be adopted to form new GCs;
- (c) Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories are to be treated separately as far as possible having regard to the statutory criteria under the Electoral Affairs Commission Ordinance;
- (d) Splitting of administrative districts by DC constituencies should be avoided unless there are very strong reasons. Where splitting is necessary, it should affect the least number of administrative districts; and
- (e) Factors with political implications are not considered.
