<p>1 November – 8 December 2022 (except Saturday, Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>Candidates can submit their specimens of postage-free election mail at either one of the following Hongkong Post offices:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● General Post Office, Central ● G/F, Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) Under the prevailing legislation, letters that may be posted free of postage <u>must not be larger than 165 mm x 245 mm</u> in size and <u>must not exceed 5 mm in thickness</u>;</p> <p>(2) To save time, Candidates may consider submitting their specimen(s) of postage-free election mail before being assigned with candidate number or confirming the printing details of the election mail; and</p> <p>(3) Once the specimen(s) concerned has/have been approved in writing by Hongkong Post, Candidates may insert the candidate number or printing details into that election mail <u>without altering the approved design and content of the election mail</u>.</p>
<p>1 November – 13 December 2022 (except Sunday and public holiday)</p>	<p>Candidates can post postage-free election mail at either one of the following acceptance offices of Hongkong Post:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● General Post Office, Central ● Bulk Mail Acceptance Counter of Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay <p><u>Remarks :</u></p> <p>(1) Candidates must select one of the acceptance offices to post their postage-free election mail when handing in the specimen(s) and “Notice of Posting of Election Mail” to Hongkong Post; and</p> <p>(2) Candidates must furnish the Postmaster General with a security (i.e. full postage of all the election mail posted) if postings of their postage-free election mail are made before the publication of the notice of valid nominations in the Gazette.</p>
