1 November – 13 December 2022 (except Sunday and public holiday)	Candidates can post postage-free election mail at either one of the following acceptance offices of Hongkong Post:- General Post Office, Central Bulk Mail Acceptance Counter of Central Mail Centre, Kowloon Bay
	Remarks: (1) Candidates must select one of the acceptance offices to post their postage-free election mail when handing in the specimen(s) and "Notice of Posting of Election Mail" to Hongkong Post; and
	(2) Candidates must furnish the Postmaster General with a security (i.e. full postage of all the election mail posted) if postings of their postage-free election mail are made before the publication of the notice of valid nominations in the Gazette.
