^{Note} According to section 75(7)(a)(ii) of the EAC(EP)(LC) Reg, any ballot paper which appears to be not marked in accordance with section 55(2), i.e. the chop is not affixed to give a single “✓” in the circle opposite the candidates of the elector’s choice, is questionable, and it should be up to the RO or the PRO to decide whether the vote is to be counted. When making decision, if the RO or the PRO believes the ballot paper is not marked with the chop provided at the polling station, the vote is not to be counted pursuant to section 80(1)(ha).
