^{Note 1} According to section 58A(4) of the EAC(EP)(LC) Reg, an elector voting for the Election Committee Constituency (“ECC”) must vote for a number of candidates that is equal to the number of Members to be returned for the ECC at the election.

^{Note 2} According to section 58A(1) of the EAC(EP)(LC) Reg, an elector voting for the ECC must use the following way to mark the ballot paper: filling in black the ovals on it opposite the names of the candidates of the elector’s choice on the ballot paper.
